	command, correct use of present tense and past tense, use of the progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense to mark actions in progress, use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences, commas in a list, apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in spelling and to mark singular possession in nouns.
